

# Original 3.0 to New 3.0 Comparison

This document is to help identify what changes OCS made to the proposed 3.0 version based on the initial feedback received during the 60-day Comment Period. Changes that did not impact data collection are not listed. One major non-data collection change was tense change under the Services such as from “receiving” to “who received.” This change is being called out because a comparison document makes it look like there were many changes to the Services when there were not a lot of substantive ones. There were no changes to Module 4 – Community Level, which is why it is not listed below.

## Module 1 – State Administration

- Section C – Organizational Standards was removed in the original 3.0 proposed report but was added back in the latest document.
- Section D – The table under D.6. was revised to include a Description of Activities column.

## Module 2 – Eligible Entity Administration

- Module Name – While no change to data collection, the name change from Eligible Entity Expenditures, Capacity, and Resources is called out for FYI purposes.
- Section A – There was a question group that was originally proposed where the EE reported on its CSBG Allocation, Carryover, Discretionary, and Discretionary Carryover. This was removed in the latest document. A screenshot of what was removed is below.

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## Module 3 – Individual and Family Level

- Service Delivery and Access – OCS originally removed the eligibility determination, referrals, and case management services. These were added back in the revised document under a Service Delivery sub-section at the beginning of Section A Services.
- All Services – OCS added “Other Service” under each of the domains. This allows the EE to report on a service that does not better fit with one of the pre-defined ones. Below is an example of the Health and Nutrition domain Other Service.

- Education Service 2r – OCS removed the evidence-based requirement under the Home Visiting Program service.
- Income and Asset Building Service 3d – OCS removed this proposed service:

- Housing Services – There was a change in order and category titles. The services are the same, but they look different visually because of these changes.
- Civic Engagement and Community Involvement Service 6c – OCS removed the following proposed service:

SRV 6c. The number of individuals that participated in self-sufficiency services (e.g.: Getting Ahead, Bridges out Poverty).
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- Transportation Services – OCS added two new services, which are below. This may be related to the removal of the transportation service under the Income and Asset Building domain.

SRV 7g. The number of individuals receiving automotive support (e.g., insurance premiums, car payment assistance, car repairs)

- All FNPIs - OCS added an Other FNPI under each of the domains. This allows the EE to report on an indicator that does not better fit with one of the pre-defined ones. Another change OCS made was word-smithing many indicators to more outcome-oriented language, such as receiving a specific service to increased access to a specific service or received a specific service to who improved because of the service. This is being called out as a more substantive change because many individuals expressed concerns that many of the proposed indicators read like services than results. Below is a screenshot of the Employment domain Other FNPI.

- Housing FNPIs – OCS changed the language of to FNPI 4e. to include Weatherization, which led to the elimination of 2.1 FNPI 4f. OCS also added a new FNPI (3.0 FNPI 4f.) about avoiding utility shut-offs or having service restored.

- Health and Nutrition FNPIs – OCS added the elderly maintaining independent living indicator. OCS also added an improved oral health indicator specific to adults.

- Civic Engagement and Community Involvement FNPI – OCS added low incomes to the indicator.
